We encourage our students to approach the design process through wide research, exploration, reflection, and investigation of diverse subjects through their projects. Kanaka Raghavan, our senior faculty member explores similar themes in her own design work. She will share her experience that highlights how design career paths can sometimes be non-linear and being a curious cross-disciplinary designer can help you carve your own unique creative career.
